Open Access Policy

Boccia Epsom and Ewell was formally established in 2005 to meet an identified need for children and young people from the Borough of Epsom and Ewell to play boccia. The club has a constitution and is run by a management committee.

Initially the club was open to players aged 6 to 16, however, over time this has evolved and the majority of players are aged between 8 and 25. Players like everyone else get older and The BEEs would not turn away any player who wishes to join and can benefit from playing whatever their age.

The club operates an open door membership policy and welcomes all players, whatever their disability, religion, gender or race. The majority of members are eligible for the elite pathway and classification under the CPISRA system. We play by the CPISRA rules and regulations.

Volunteers are welcome at the club subject to references being taken up. An enhanced CRB check is required for all volunteers over the age of 16.

The club is affiliated to Boccia England who achieved Sport England National Governing Body status in 2011.
