

Visitors to Boccia Epsom and Ewell (The BEEs)

Code of Conduct

1. Visitors must be approved before attending The BEEs. In the first instance contact the Club Chair; Liz Moulam via lizmoulam@aol.com
2. All visitors to The BEEs must be accompanied by an adult member of the club at all times.
3. No visitor to The BEEs must be left alone with a player at any time during the visit.
4. It is the responsibility of the designated session leader to inform club members (including players, coaches, assistants, volunteers, parents and carers) of the purpose of the visit.
5. If research is to be undertaken a copy of the host organisation's ethical approval for the project must be available.
6. No photographs or videos may be taken without the express consent of individual club members. Any photographs or videos made by a visitor must be made available to The BEEs to use in printed and electronic publicity/media
7. No visitor will solicit personal information from any club member
8. Club members who agree to be interviewed, talk to or take part in any fact finding or discussion with visitors must give informed consent to take part. For a club member under 18 this must be from a parent or guardian.
9. Club members who agree to be interviewed, talk to or take part in any fact finding or discussion with visitors have the opportunity to withdraw from the process at any time, and/or request their views, opinions and images are deleted/returned and not used in any way.
10. Visitors will not approach a player during a skills session or a game. They must agree a convenient time for any interview or discussion.
